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There are only a few Protestant churches here. And we understand as yet so little Portuguese that we have not discovered where there is a church for English-speaking folk. Of course we intend to go to a Portuguese church, but it is something we shall accustom ourselves to by stages because whenever we go it calls for another lesson in the language and our brains and bodies grow weary. I'll tell you more in a month or so. Suffice it to say that Portugal has about one Protestant to every thousand Catholics. Now, love until the next and God be with you both and all, Or a chie
